## ITI Tech Voting Guide for the 113th Congress

(2013-2015)

The ITI Tech Voting Guide serves as both a report card for members of Congress on key policy issues facing the technology sector, and as a reflection of ITI's legislative priorities for the 113th Congress (2013-2015).

## House Vote Ratings for the 113th Congress

**H.R. 624, Cyber Information Sharing and Protection Act:** Legislation improving the ability of the private sector to voluntarily share cyber threat information with others in the private sector and the federal government.

ITI's Position: **Yea**

*ITI believes increased voluntary cyber threat information sharing between the private sector and the government and within the private sector is critical to protecting individuals and U.S. businesses. H.R. 624 included provisions that safeguard individuals' information while allowing for a cyber threat information sharing system that helps to protect us all online.*

**H.Res. 354, Helium Stewardship Act of 2013:** Legislation reauthorizing the federal government's authority to sell helium to the private sector, and effectively ending the Federal Helium Reserve program within 10 years.

ITI's Position: **Yea**

*Helium is a critical, irreplaceable component in a variety of advanced, high-tech manufacturing processes, as well as cutting-edge scientific research. With more than 40 percent of the world's helium supply held by the Federal Helium Reserve program, the ability for the federal government to sell helium to the private sector is imperative. H.Res. 354 ensured the reauthorization and much needed reform of the Federal Helium Reserve program.*

**H.R. 3309, Innovation Act:** Legislation aimed at reducing abusive patent litigation rendered by non-practicing entities (NPEs) against legitimate patent holders.

ITI's Position: **Yea**

*With significant patent portfolios tied to numerous goods and services around the world, many ITI member companies are forced to divert considerable resources to defending themselves against abusive and expensive lawsuits. These lawsuits are a tax on innovation and a drain on our nation's judicial system and economy. H.R. 3309 represented a significant step forward in reforming the patent system.*

# House Vote Ratings for the 113th Congress

**H.R. 4438, American Research and Competitiveness Act of 2014:** Legislation modernizing the U.S. tax code by establishing a permanent research and development (R&D) tax credit.

ITI's Position: Yea

*A permanent R&D tax credit would reward and incentivize domestic innovation in the United States, as well as mark a real step forward in modernizing our outdated tax code. H.R. 4438 created a more stable and predictable tax environment, allowing ITI member companies to better compete in today's hypercompetitive global marketplace.*

**H.R. 5771, Tax Increase Prevention Act of 2014:** Legislation reinstating a number of tax provisions, including the renewal of the R&D tax credit.

ITI's Position: Yea

*The U.S. tax code is in dire need of an upgrade. In the absence of comprehensive tax reform, failure to extend the R&D tax credit would raise taxes on our businesses and stunt both investments and job growth in the United States. H.R. 5771 ensured the extension of the R&D credit through 2014.*
